Covenant House Missouri has 32 Rights of Passage-Transitional Living Program (ROP-TLP) rooms--sixteen for girls and sixteen for boys. Components of the ROP-TLP include not only shelter, but also counseling, budgeting, life skills, employment assistance, educational referrals, and recreational outings. ROP-TLP clients may also continue to access services from the day services provided in the Center for Youth. Residents in the ROP-TLP may remain in housing for up to 24 months.

Epworth may have Youth Emergency Service shelter that provides food and housing to youth experiencing homelessness or family crisis.
